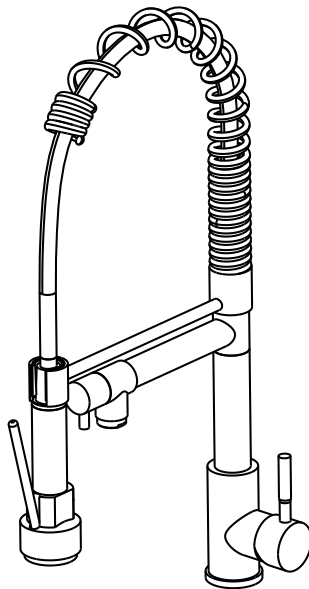

SAFETY NOTES

- ⚠ WARNING: To prevent product failure, property damage, and personal injury, please follow these guidelines:
- ⚠ Ensure that all necessary parts are available by referring to the diagram and parts list.
- ⚠ Ensure that your basin matches the kitchen faucet size.
- ⚠ Do not disassemble the main faucet body, as it has been properly installed and tested before delivery from the factory.
- ⚠ Turn off the hot and cold water supply before starting the installation.
- ⚠ To prevent the faucet from clogging, flush the water pipes before installation.
- ⚠ After completing the installation, check all joints and connections for leaks.

INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

CRANACH recommended that this unit be installed by a licensed professional plumber.

Before starting the installation, please read these instructions carefully and make sure you have all the required tools and materials on hand.

Keep this booklet and the receipt (or other proof of date and place of purchase) for this product in a safe place. The receipt is required should it be necessary to request warranty parts.

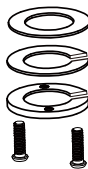

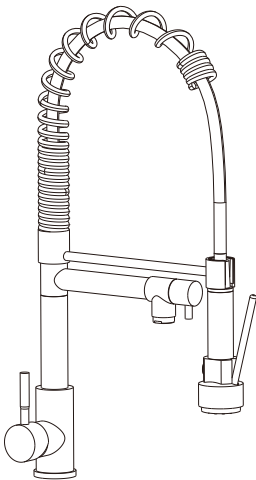
Tailpiece Nut Assembly

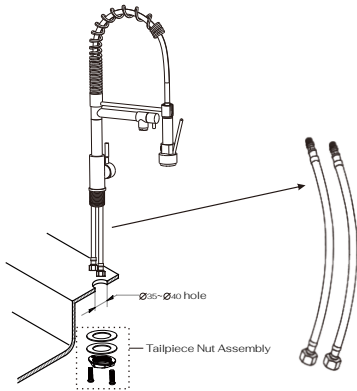
Faucet Body

INSTALLATION

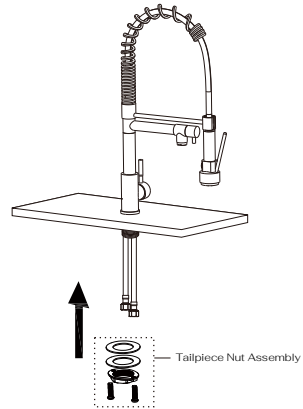
1



1. Drill a hole in the installation surface (35-40mm) and remove the tailpiece nut assembly.

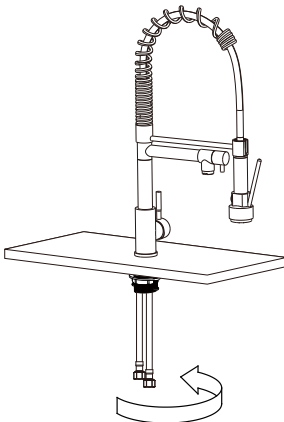
2. Connect the hot and cold water pipes to the corresponding port on the faucet body.

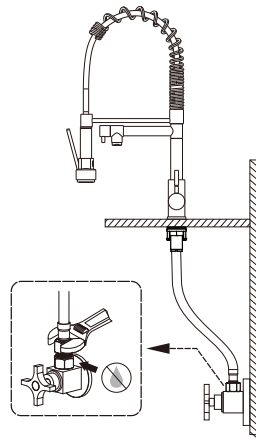
Insert faucet body into the hole on the countertop. Attach Tailpiece Nut Assembly from underneath the sink.

Adjust direction of faucet body. Tighten Tailpiece Nut Assembly until snug.

Connect the red and blue hoses to the corresponding hot and cold inlet pipes of the faucet body, then connect the other ends to the hot and cold angle valves. Tighten them with a wrench and turn on the hot and cold water to test for leaks.

WARRANTY

Parts and Finish:

All parts (excluding electronic parts and batteries) and finishes of CRANACH products purchased from authorized CRANACH sellers are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship for as long as the original consumer purchaser owns the home in which the faucet(s) are installed.

For commercial purchasers or multi-family residential properties (such as apartments and condominiums), the warranty period is 10 years from the date the product is received by the original purchaser or their authorized representative (e.g., installation contractor).

Electronic Parts:

Electronic parts (excluding batteries), if applicable, that are part of CRANACH products purchased from cranachhome.com or authorized CRANACH sellers are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship for 5 years from the date the product is received for residential use, 1 year for commercial purchasers. Batteries are not covered under this warranty.

What We Will Do:

If a defect is found during the applicable warranty period, CRANACH will provide replacement parts free of charge. This includes any part or finish that proves defective in material or workmanship under normal installation, use, and service. Before returning your faucet to CRANACH, please visit our website or contact our customer service team (via phone or email) for troubleshooting assistance.

Exclusions & Limitations:

This warranty does not cover damage caused by abuse, misuse, or improper care, lack of maintenance or improper installation, freezing water or excessive water pressure, abrasive cleaning products, or use in violation of applicable codes or regulations. Labor charges incurred during installation, repair, or replacement, damage incurred during installation or removal, or incidental or consequential damages, are excluded.

CARE AND CLEANING

Gently clean the product with clear water and wipe dry using a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use soaps, acid, polish, abrasives or rough materials that may damage the surface.
