
Unscrew the decorative shower panel, shower head body, and fix frame respectively, according to the mark (Remove/Install) on the top of the decorative shower panel.




Install the power socket in the appropriate position, lay out the water pipeline, and connect it to the valve.




Reserve installation holes on the ceiling according to the dimensions shown in the diagram.




Fasten the fix frame to the wooden frame with screws.




Install the transformer, and connect to the power socket illustrated.




Connect the WiFi controller and power supply. Secure connections with electrical tape and fix the frame.




Connect the WiFi controller to the power supply and secure it with adhesive tape.




Connect the corrugated pipe between the embedded water pipe and the rear water inlet of the shower head.



Install the main body of the overhead shower.




Test the overhead shower spray to ensure proper water flow and functionality after installation



Attach the decorative shower panel to the shower head body.

Power supply management:

The remote will enter standby mode (untouchable state) if pressed for more than 20 seconds. If this occurs, please slightly shake it once and the remote will return to normal working state (touchable state).

Indicator light instruction:

1.When the PWR indicator light is bright, the remote is either idle or sending a signal; when the PWR light is off, it will enter standby mode. 2.When RF is bright, it means the remote is sending signal; off means there is no signal sending.





- 7.Before power-on debugging, ensure that all wiring is correct to avoid damage to the luminaire due to wiring errors.




When removing the threaded pipe, handle it with care to avoid damaging the threads or other components.



Apply an appropriate amount of teflon tape to the 1/2 NPT threaded pipe to create a secure seal at the connection point. Avoid overwrapping to prevent improper fitting.



When attaching the bodyjet, tighten it securely without applying excessive force to avoid compromising the nozzle or the wall structure.




Once all installation steps are complete, inspect for any water leaks or loose connections to ensure a fully secure and stable setup.

- 2. Align the plastic ring (A) with the handwheel pin (B) to ensure accurate temperature control.



WARRANTY

Parts and Finish:

All parts (excluding electronic parts and batteries) and finishes of CRANACH products purchased from authorized CRANACH sellers are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship for as long as the original consumer purchaser owns the home in which the faucet(s) are installed.

For commercial purchasers or multi-family residential properties (such as apartments and condominiums), the warranty period is 10 years from the date the product is received by the original purchaser or their authorized representative (e.g., installation contractor).

Electronic Parts:

Electronic parts (excluding batteries), if applicable, that are part of CRANACH products purchased from cranachhome.com or authorized CRANACH sellers are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship for 5 years from the date the product is received for residential use, 1 year for commercial purchasers. Batteries are not covered under this warranty.

What We Will Do:

If a defect is found during the applicable warranty period, CRANACH will provide replacement parts free of charge. This includes any part or finish that proves defective in material or workmanship under normal installation, use, and service. Before returning your faucet to CRANACH, please visit our website or contact our customer service team (via phone or email) for troubleshooting assistance.
