

## INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

CRANACH recommends that this unit be installed by a licensed professional plumber.

Before starting the installation, please read these instructions carefully and make sure you have all the required tools and materials on hand.

To avoid the risk of scalding, ensure that the maximum output temperature of the shower mixing valve does not exceed 120°F (49°C).

# INSTALLATION

1



1. Unscrew the decorative shower panel, shower head body, and fix frame respectively, according to the mark (Remove/Install) on the top of the decorative shower panel.




2. Install the power socket in the appropriate position, lay out the water pipeline, and connect it to the valve.


3. Reserve installation holes on the ceiling according to the dimensions shown in the diagram.


4. Fasten the fix frame to the wooden frame with screws.

5. Install the transformer, and connect to the power socket illustrated.



6. Connect the WiFi controller and power supply. Secure connections with electrical tape and fix the frame.



- ③ connect the Power supply and sound.




7. Connect the WiFi controller to the power supply and secure it with adhesive tape.


8. Connect the corrugated pipe between the embedded water pipe and the rear water inlet of the shower head.


9. Install the main body of the overhead shower.

10. Test the overhead shower spray to ensure proper water flow and functionality after installation



# LED CONTROLLER INSTRUCTION

The touch remote features 9 touch keys, each designed for specific functions as follows:



- ① Turn ON/OFF  
⑤ Mode Switch ② Color Touch Ring  
③/⑥ Color Temperature adjusting  
④/⑦ Dynamic Speed adjusting  
⑦/⑨ Dynamic Brightness adjusting

Mode:

| NO. | FUNCTION          | REMOTE  |
|-----|-------------------|---|
| 1   | Static red        | Brightness is adjustable.<br>Speed is unadjustable. |
| 2   | Static green      |   |
| 3   | Static blue       |   |
| 4   | RGB Jumping       |   |

| 7   | Static white      |   |
| 8   | Static purple     | Brightness is adjustable.<br>Speed is adjustable.   |
| 9   | RGB Gradual       |   |

Power supply management:

The remote will enter standby mode (untouchable state) if pressed for more than 20 seconds. If this occurs, please slightly shake it once and the remote will return to normal working state (touchable state).

Indicator light instruction:

1. When the PWR indicator light is bright, the remote is either idle or sending a signal; when the PWR light is off, it will enter standby mode.
2. When RF is bright, it means the remote is sending signal; off means there is no signal sending.

Remarks:

1. This product should be commissioned and installed by qualified personnel.
2. This product cannot be waterproof; it needs to be protected from sun and rain. If installed outdoors, please use a waterproof box.
3. Good heat dissipation conditions will extend the life of the LED controller. Please install the product in a well-ventilated environment.
4. Please do not install or use such products in lightning, thunder, strong magnetic or high voltage applications.
5. Please check whether the output voltage of the LED power supply used meets the product voltage range requirements.
6. The diameter of the wire used must be sufficient to support the connected LED luminaire, and ensure that the wiring is secure to avoid the wire overheating or poor contact triggering an accident.
7. Before power-on debugging, ensure that all wiring is correct to avoid damage to the luminaire due to wiring errors.

# WARRANTY

## Parts and Finishes:

CRANACH warrants all parts (excluding electronic components and batteries) and finishes of this product, purchased from authorized CRANACH sellers, to be free from defects in material and workmanship.

- Residential Use:

Lifetime warranty, for as long as the original consumer purchaser owns the home in which the product is installed.

- Commercial or Multi-Family Use:

For a period of ten (10) years from the date the product is received by the original purchaser or their authorized representative.

## Electronic Components:

If applicable, electronic components (excluding batteries) of CRANACH products purchased from cranachhome.com or authorized CRANACH sellers are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship.

- Residential Use:

For a period of five (5) years from the date the product is received.

- Commercial or Multi-Family Use:

For a period of one (1) year from the date the product is received.

## What We Will Do:

During the applicable warranty period, if a defect is found in material or workmanship under normal installation, use, and service, CRANACH will provide replacement parts free of charge. Before returning your product to CRANACH, please visit our website or contact our customer service team (via phone or email) for troubleshooting assistance.

## Exclusions & Limitations:

This warranty does not cover:

- Damage caused by abuse, misuse, improper care, lack of maintenance, or improper installation.
- Damage from freezing water or excessive water pressure.
- Damage from abrasive cleaning products or use in violation of applicable codes or regulations.
- Labor charges incurred during installation, removal, or repair of the product.
- Incidental or consequential damages.
