

INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

CRANACH recommends that this unit be installed by a licensed professional plumber.

Before starting the installation, please read these instructions carefully and make sure you have all the required tools and materials on hand.

To avoid the risk of scalding, ensure that the maximum output temperature of the shower mixing valve does not exceed 120°F (49°C).

1. Water circuit diagram of lavatory faucet.



2. The installation depth of rough-in valve should be no less than 2" (55mm) and no more than 2 3/4" (70mm), including the thickness of tile. Otherwise the deck plate cannot be installed.



3. Measure and mark the installation points based on the dimensions of the rough-in valve. Drill holes into the concrete wall at the marked locations and insert the wall anchors.



4. Secure the rough-in valve to the wall using screws inserted into the wall anchors. Connect the hot and cold water inlet pipes to their respective inlets.

5.1 Wrap the spout adapter with waterproof tape, then rotate and thread it into the pre-installed mounting body. (Note: The threading depth of the spout adapter must be adjusted according to the actual embedded depth of the pre-installed body.)

5.2 Align the deck plate with the mounting holes and insert it into the pre-installed body.


5.3 Finally, install the spout and handle into the pre-installed body according to the diagram, then tighten the screws. Turn on the water supply and check for leaks at all connection points

6. Disassemble the drain from the bottom and remove all components as shown.

7. Insert the drain into the basin hole, then from underneath, attach the rubber gasket, washer, and brass sleeve. Tighten the sleeve by turning it right, but do not over-tighten.

WARRANTY

Parts and Finishes:

For a period of ten (10) years from the date the product is received by the original purchaser or their authorized representative.

Electronic Components:

If applicable, electronic components (excluding batteries) of CRANACH products purchased from cranachhome.com or authorized CRANACH sellers are warranted to the original consumer purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship.

- Residential Use:

For a period of five (5) years from the date the product is received.

- Commercial or Multi-Family Use:

For a period of one (1) year from the date the product is received.

What We Will Do:

During the applicable warranty period, if a defect is found in material or workmanship under normal installation, use, and service, CRANACH will provide replacement parts free of charge. Before returning your product to CRANACH, please visit our website or contact our customer service team (via phone or email) for troubleshooting assistance.

Exclusions & Limitations:

This warranty does not cover:

- Damage caused by abuse, misuse, improper care, lack of maintenance, or improper installation.
- Damage from freezing water or excessive water pressure.
- Damage from abrasive cleaning products or use in violation of applicable codes or regulations.
- Labor charges incurred during installation, removal, or repair of the product.
- Incidental or consequential damages.
